ELLORA CAVES

Chh. Sambhajinagar is the Historic City

Ellora is UNESCO World Heritage Site Located in the Chh. Sambhajinagar district of Maharashtra, India. It is one of the largest Rock-cut monastery temple cave complexes In the world, featuring Hindu, Buddist and Jain monuments, and artwork, dating from The 600-1000 CE period.

AJANTA CAVES

Buddhist rock-cut cave temples and monasteries, located near Ajanta village, northcentral Maharashtra state, western India, are celebrated for their wall paintings. The temples are hollowed out of granite cliffs on the inner side of a 70-foot (20-metre) ravine in the Wagurna River valley 65 miles (105 km) northeast of Chh. Sambhajinagar, at a site of great scenic beauty. These paintings depict colourful Buddhist legends and divinities with an exuberance and vitality that is unsurpassed in Indian art. The caves were designated a UNESCO World Heritage site in 1983.

DEVGIRI FORT

Daulatabad Fort, also known as Devgiri or Deogiri, is a historic fortified citadel located in Daultabad village near Chh. Sambhajinagar, Maharashtra, India. It was the capital of the Yadava dynasty, for a brief time the capital Of the Delhi Sultanate, and later a secondary Capital of the Ahmadnagar Sultanate.

BIBI KA MAQBARA (DAKKAN TAJ MAHAL)

The Bibi Ka Magbara is a tomb located in Chh. Sambhajinagar, Maharashtra, India. It was Commissioned in 1660 by the Mughal Emperor Aurangzeb in the memory of his First and chief wife Dilras Banu Begum and Is considered to be a symbol of Aurangzeb's conjugal fidelity.

GHRISHNESHWAR TEMPLE

The is one of the 12 most important temples In India dedicated to Lord Shiva, which Makes it significant, and draws thousands of Pilgrims throughout the year.
